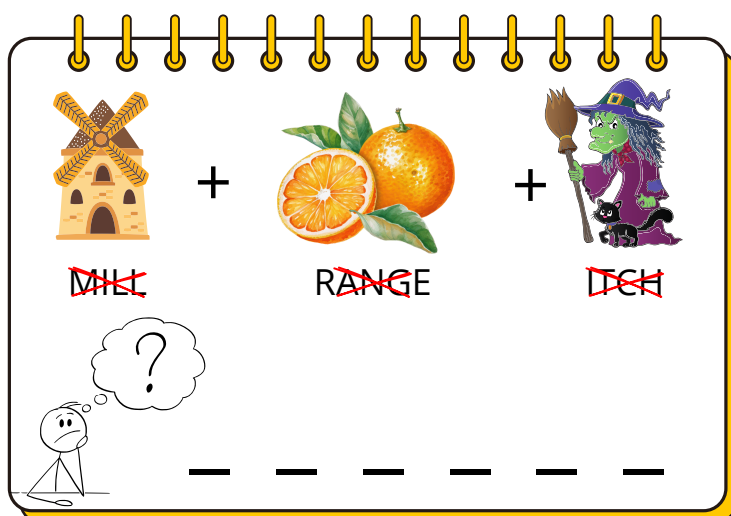
Yamal or Vini?

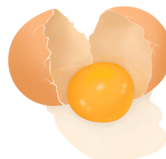


1. Crocodiles can live up to 100 years.
