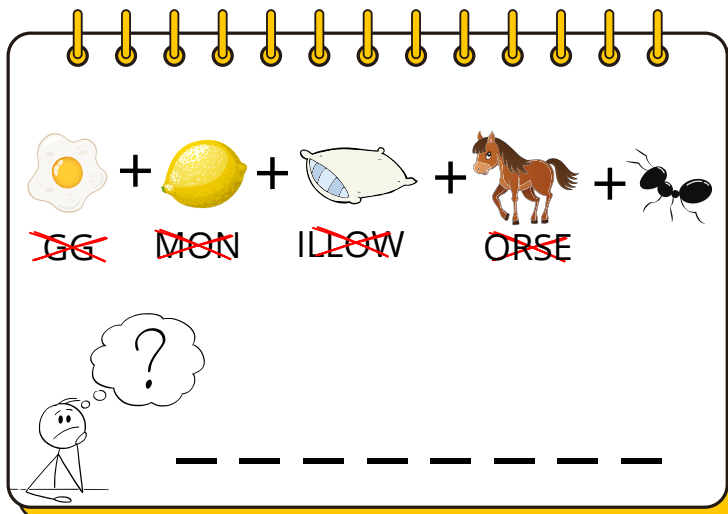

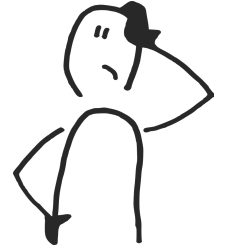

Anna was scared. Tom held her hand. Dracula came closer. "You should not be here," he said. "Go now."

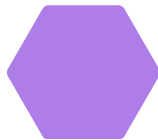
They turned and ran down the stairs. The door opened again by itself. They ran outside and didn't stop until they were back in the village.

Since that night, they never went near the castle again. But sometimes, they saw a dark figure at the window. And sometimes, they heard a voice in the wind, saying, "Come back..."

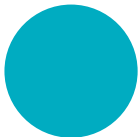

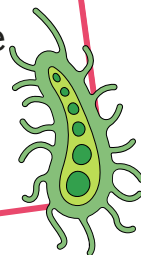

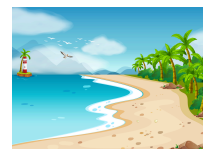
